Idaho Physician Shortage Facts

THE PROBLEM

Physician supply lags patient demand nationally and across Idaho. As supply falls, patients wait longer to see a doctor, and doctors burn out.



The U.S. is projected to have 120,000 too few doctors nationally.

- ▶ Nearly 40% of American physicians will reach retirement age by 2030.1
- ▶ By 2030, the United States will face a shortage of over 120,000 physicians.²

Idaho ranks in the bottom half of all states for primary care doctor availability and overall physician supply.4

50th in total physician supply

49th in active primary physicians

50th in general surgeons



Idaho is projected to be short 1.743 doctors by 2030.

Primary care alone is projected to be short 382 providers.3

39 of Idaho's 44 **counties** are health professional shortage areas (HPSAs).5

- ▶ Low-income citizens are disproportionately affected by these shortages.
- ▶ HPSA designations indicate areas where there are 3,500 or more patients for every one provider.6
