

Colorado Physician Shortage Facts

THE PROBLEM

Physician supply lags patient demand nationally and across Colorado. As supply falls, patients wait longer to see a doctor, and doctors burn out.

BY 2030

The U.S. is projected to have **120,000 too few** doctors nationally.¹⁻³



- Nearly 40% of American physicians will reach retirement age.
- The United States will face a shortage of over 120,000 physicians.
- ▶ 31.2% of Colorado physicians are within retirement range right now.


Colorado is projected to be short 2,424 doctors.⁴⁻⁵



- Primary care alone is projected to be short 1,773 providers.
- Rural regions east of Denver have ratios as high as 5,636 residents for each primary care provider.

54 of Colorado's 64 counties are health professional shortage areas (HPSA).⁶⁻⁷

- Low-income citizens are disproportionately affected by these shortages.
- HPSA designations indicate areas where there are 3,500 or more patients for every one provider.



Ranked against other states, Colorado's doctor-to-patient ratio is:

25% worse for infectious diseases

20% worse in internal medicine 15% worse in neurology 11% worse in psychiatry
